2015 UCI Road World Championships

Richmond will play host to cyclists and sporting enthusiasts from all over the globe Sept. 19-27 as the 2015 Road World Championships mark the return of cycling's pinnacle event to the United States for the first time in nearly 30 years. State employees will be right in the middle of the action as the 12 world championship races wind their way around the Richmond area and downtown. The nine-day event will feature about 1,000 cyclists from more than 70 countries. The event is projected to attract a total attendance of 450,000 spectators from the Richmond region and across the globe over the nine days of racing and draw a television audience of more than 300 million. The economic impact for the Commonwealth of Virginia is anticipated to be approximately \$158 million.

WORK OPTIONS

State employees will have a front row seat to the action as cyclists from around the world descend on Richmond to race for their respective countries. Steps were taken during the planning of the event to provide for as little disruption as possible during the workweek while still allowing employees easy access to the events. While employees are encouraged to report to work as usual during the race week, there are several options for those who want to make time during the week to enjoy the festivities. Work options include:

Telework: Employees with current Telework Agreements could work from their designated remote locations during the event.

Schedule Adjusting: Employees may be permitted to adjust their work hours during the event.

Alternate Work Location: Agencies may direct employees in impacted areas to report to work at alternate agency locations. Agencies must ensure that accommodations for space, work-related resources, and supervision are in place to ensure a productive workday.

Personal Leave: Employees may use their personal leave, which must be requested and approved in advance.

STATE ID BADGES

State employees will be required to show their identification badges to access parking, state buildings and for other special events. **Keep it on you at all times!**


